Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon. The ascent is usually continued in the Hühnerbach. Traditionally called Pitzbach, but according to the official Austrian watercourse map Rotwandersbach. The Pitzbach is only a left side stream of the Rotwandersbach, which is not touched at all on this tour. The incorrect designation is due to the fact that only the side stream was designated as Pitzbach in the Alpine Club map of the time and it was therefore apparently assumed that this was the main stream.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Bad Tölz via Lenggries to Sylvensteinsee. Turn left there and drive 5.6 km on the B 307 towards Achensee. Immediately after the road bridge over the Walchen (Achenbach), park your vehicle on the right. Alternatively, take the B 181 from Achensee in the direction of Lenggries (17.4 km from Camping Achensee).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot take the forest road that runs in a westerly direction towards the Hühnerbach. Then high above the Hühnerbach in a southerly direction. where on the right a grassy slope leads down to the stream (a little over 900 m above sea level), is the exit. For the entry, continue on the forest road for about 10 minutes until you reach a fork in the road. Here you stay on the right and look for the path a few meters further on, which leads to the stream on the right.		
Tour: (machine translated) A total of 8 rappels, a narrow section towards the exit and usually a lot of wood in the stream. At the 28m rappel there is an alternative 35m rappel on the right, but this is usually quite low in water.		
Return: (machine translated) Turn right onto the barely recognizable slope that meets the access path. Follow this back to the car. Alternatively, continue along the Hühnerbach.

Everything else is good, except for the second to last jump after the tree section which is only slightly deeper than knee-deep.. might want to downclimb that one!

Water level enormously high due to melting snow. We got out before the narrow section at the exit of the canyon. Very unpleasant return flow - see 2 picture. (machine translated)

First pool is getting deeper again, can be jumped from the middle. Slide may be possible, the water level was too high to try it out. Not yet deep enough to jump from the top again. Second jump doable with bent knees. Some trees in the way after the winter. Anchor on the high rappel was loose, tightened it again. Other anchors are all fine. Rope at the tree-block is gone, new one should be installed. Downclimbing with a rope is easier and almost safer than rappelling here. Final jump is deep enough to jump.
