By the TF51 between Arona and Los Cristianos

From the TF1 freeway we will take the TF28, just a kilometer further and almost arriving at the South hospital, we have a track on the left where we will leave the car to return.

We will follow the TF28 passing Chayofa a couple of kilometers more until the traffic circle from where the TF51 to Arona leaves, where we will take another 2 kilometers to the Jungle Park detour. Here we have a small place on one side to park the access car.

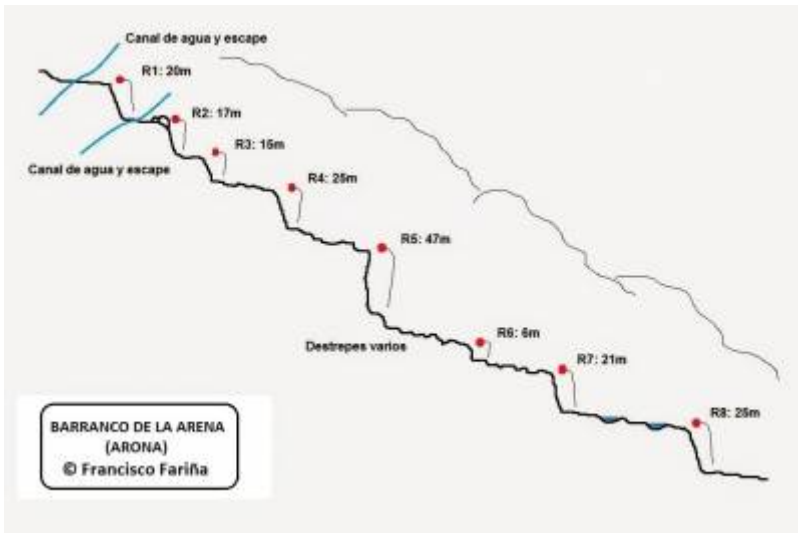
