Summary: (machine translated) Unlike most of the canyons on the island, this one is more aquatic and less vertical. Good formations, a very fun canyon and perfect to start canyoning because of its low difficulty. The only difficulty is how long the activity can be done. Possibility to do it with 1 or 2 vehicles, in both options you have to carry a headlamp to pass the channel tunnel. Check for possible prohibitions of the canyon! Within the Teno Rural Park Use and Management Plan (PRUG). Permission must be requested at the cabildo		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We are located next to Buenavista del Norte, in the village of Los Silos on the TF42. Just in the village, p.k. 11.5 Susana street comes out and there are the signs to Cuevas Negras, here there is a place to leave the car for the return. Access to Salto, Mantuba, Cueva Negra and Cochinos banks. We continue up to the traffic circle at p.k. 11 and take it up to Tierra del Trigo, once there we go up to the hermitage of Nuestra Sra de Lourdes, right next to it we park, if we go with two vehicles, the access vehicle.		
Approach: (machine translated) Approaches to Salto, Mantuba, Cueva Negra and Cochinos bcos. If we only have one vehicle, we will go up the trail that goes up the Cuevas Negras oxbow lake. Along the path of the Rijos until a path to our right that passes the Juan Alonso oxbow to a track. We continue and we find the water channel of the Lomo Morín lake, we surpass it and follow the path until a water conduit by which we continue until a first tunnel, we will go to the right to surpass the hill until the exit of the channel to the other side, we descend by the path until the Cuevas Negras lake and we continue to the following hill. We continue next to the channel until we reach the second tunnel that we will have to cross (foresee the frontals), we pass another small tunnel and at its exit we continue a little to a right curve to go down to the ravine.

Return: (machine translated) We continue along the ravine until we reach a trail that leads to the Silos PR trail.
