Also called Canal de les Lluastres, this is a single rappel on a wall that houses a cave, so it will be a flying rappel with nothing else. To complete the day with any other descent in the area and visit the cave.

If we find it with water, only after heavy rains, we will see a nice waterfall over the cave. The rest of the time it is a collection canyon.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We are located in Àrnes, on the T330. We will enter by the side of Valderrobles (from the river) to take Aragon Street. After 200m we have a detour to the right to Toll de Vidre that we will take. By this track/road we will go towards the Coll de la Creu here a track comes out on our left, in quite bad condition and after 600m it goes down towards the Caseta de Rabosí where we will park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Bcos Rabosi area

From the Rabosí hut we will go down the track towards the Gros ravine, when we get down we follow it for about 50m and we will see a path that goes up to the Serrall de Tossetes, through the Racó de Pataqueret leaving the Cova del Fideu on the left.

Access Tomaca and Pataqueret

To the right we have the Salt de les Coves de Tomaca, just to the right is a small path, quite blurred and loser that takes us back to the channeling of rainwater, here we head towards the vertical.

Tour: (machine translated)

Only the jump over the cave where the final part is 12m of overhang. Beautiful if it has water

We will walk down to the dry creek and the access trail
