Then there are some picturesque waterfalls until you reach the first hydroelectric power plants at the exit and soon walk to the left of the river towards the parking lot		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Surprisingly much water, but also very defensively placed anchors		
Access: (machine translated) Park in lumino at the top of the cable car parking lot		
Approach: (machine translated) Two options, both bad. The orographic variant on the right goes up on a good hiking trail to the bolchetta haipin bends. From there, descend steeply to the streambed. Tricky, laborious. Variant two orographic left is described at https://canyon.li/riale-grande/ described
