Access: (machine translated)

Access downstream: From Masera, take the 55 33 from the Simplon Pass in the direction of Milan and exit at Gravellona Toce. Drive straight on through the town in the direction of Omegna. Turn left at the traffic circle and follow the signs for Novara (Omegna bypass). At the exit of the long tunnel, hairpin bends in the direction of Omegna. As you enter the town, turn right towards Agrano. If the tunnel is closed, drive through the town of Omegna until you reach the junction for Agrano. In Agrano, park near the public park or, if possible, just before the bridge over the Pescone (limited parking).

Access downstream: hairpin bends back to Agrano and turn right into Via Mottarone (very narrow road). Follow this road as it leaves the village and begins to climb. Park near the Agriturismo "1 Glicine - Alpe Selviana" or just behind it.

Access upstream: At the Caslti bridge, continue to Cicogna and park in the village.

Approach: (machine translated)

Enter the agriturismo and cross it (ask kindly for permission as you pass). Continue across the meadows on a flat path until you find a path that leads down to the stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

6 waterfalls, including a beautiful slide. The 35 m high waterfall is subdivided to -10 m.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last rappel, exit to the right and follow a downhill path that leads back to the road and shortly afterwards to the parked car.
