Take the A1 (via Milan) or the A21 (via Brescia) to Piacenza (southern exit). On a bypass to the south around the city, then on the SS 45 through the Val di Trebbia via Bobbio to Marsaglia. Before the bridge turn left on SP 586 (Chiavari). At km 12 - Ruffinati - turn right over a bridge and up a narrow winding asphalt road to Lisore and on to a panoramic road. At the top (about 1050 m) turn left to Rovereto and continue on the high road to Orezzoli. About 300 m after this village, an unpaved road turns left to Lenguie. Pass this hamlet and park the car near the next hairpin bend, about 100 m before the exit.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the hamlet at the exit of the road, a path leads down to the stream. After about 80 m you reach the first rappelling point.

Tour: (machine translated)

Only short runs. Several times rappel through the water flow. Some jumps possible, but check well, because strong bedload guidance. Is also commercially walked ('Buccia di Banana'). The Colombaia could be temporally well connected with the Rio Grande.

Return: (machine translated)

At the second (?) tributary from the left you leave the canyon still before a large pool. The difference in altitude between the entrance and exit is about 200 meters. The path, which is hardly recognizable in parts, is marked with red dots. After about 10 minutes over the wooded ridge, a mule track leads to the left flank of Colombaia (watch out!). The path climbs gently - finally crossing a side stream - to the starting point. Attention: If you continue to follow the red dots, you will end up in Orezzoli!
