Neighboring ravine of El Resbalón, with enough undergrowth in its access, parts of its development and in the return. We will have to do it in the rainy season to make sure that it carries water, that yes caution that the return is done by the river Meruelo (see flow in Molinaseca).

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From Ponferrada on the LE-142 towards Molinaseca and Compludo. We will go along this road until the pk 47, here we will find a bridge over a stream and shortly before a place to park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Immediately, there is a small path that leads down to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

It starts with a lot of brambles and thick vegetation (take pruning shears), we will reach the first rapel from a tree, after which we walk through brambles again for a while. From here the second rapel is a small balcony with a nice waterfall, and the canyon becomes more interesting (and the brambles partly disappear).

Return: (machine translated)

We will arrive at the Meruelo river and we will follow it for 300m (be careful with the riverbed), before a rocky narrowing a "path" of milestones comes out that takes us up to the road. Once on it we will only have to walk 600m to the car.

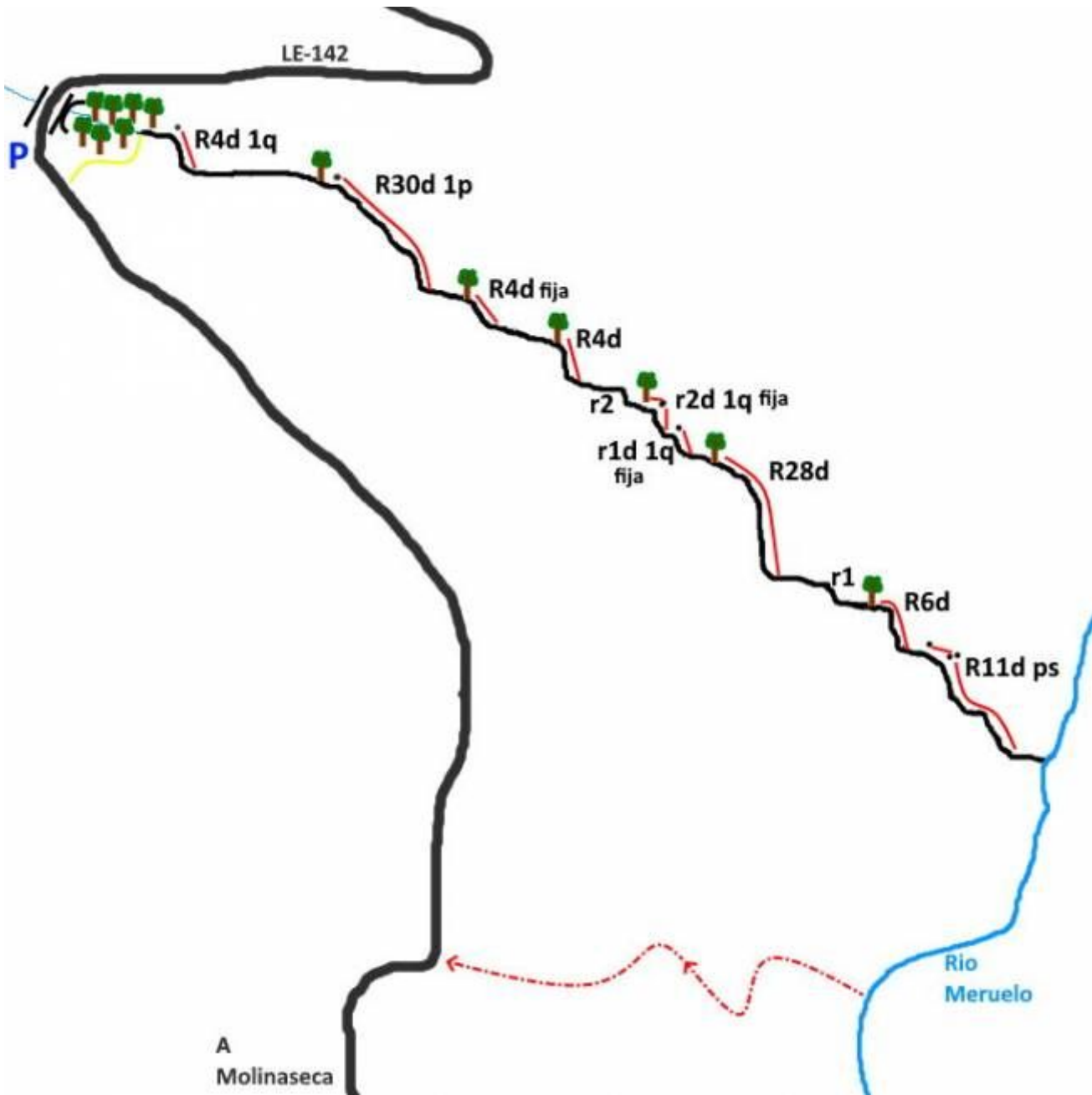
