If you are coming from St. Denis, at the entrance to St. Benoit, take the D53 towards Abondance and continue towards the Takamaka power station. Park just before the bridge that crosses the canyon, near the kiosks. The last waterfall of Dudu Sup can be seen from the parking lot, with signs indicating a large canyon.

The trail follows the ridge that runs to the right of the canyon almost continuously.

The equipment is generally in order, all relays are linked, some of the old, heavily rusted equipment is still present...

Differences to the topographic view from 05.08.11:

R3 - the single point is duplicated

R8 - 1 single point from MC has been sensibly placed to link up and reach the relay safely.

R9 - + 1 point from MC and 1 at the relay. Many of the old points are rusted and crushed, unfortunately they cannot be dismantled, they are lying around everywhere!

R13 - + 1 point

R14 - + 1 point There were already several, but as explained above, the steel bolts are broken.
