Alpine canyon with water only in spring due to thaws. Fantastic environment, good atmosphere and very aesthetic. The unfrequented environment gives it an added attraction.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

By the C462 that connects La Seu d'Urgell with Sant Llorenç de Morunys, next to the Coll de Port we will find Tuixent.

We could also go by the side of Gosol by the B400.

After leaving Tuixent to Coll de Port cross the river Mola and right there is a track to our left that goes up to Planells del Sastró, pass this recreational area and continue until you find a sharp left turn with stairs on the right and a water collection house. Place to park the return car.

With the access car we will continue along the track to the Coll de Mola where we will park.

This same track goes down to Gosol because we can also access from there.

Approach: (machine translated)

If we only take one car, we will follow the marks of the GR to the coll.

Once at the coll de Mola, a track comes out on the right that in a little more than 1.5 km leaves us at the torrent. The views along the entire route are magnificent.

Tour: (machine translated)

Alpine descent, generally without water except in spring and thaw, which is the ideal time. The beginning of the canyon does not inspire much, since it is very open and with little substance, but little by little, it will close up to the cirque. Then it will open up again to reach the final stretch.

Return: (machine translated)

We will follow the ravine to the track

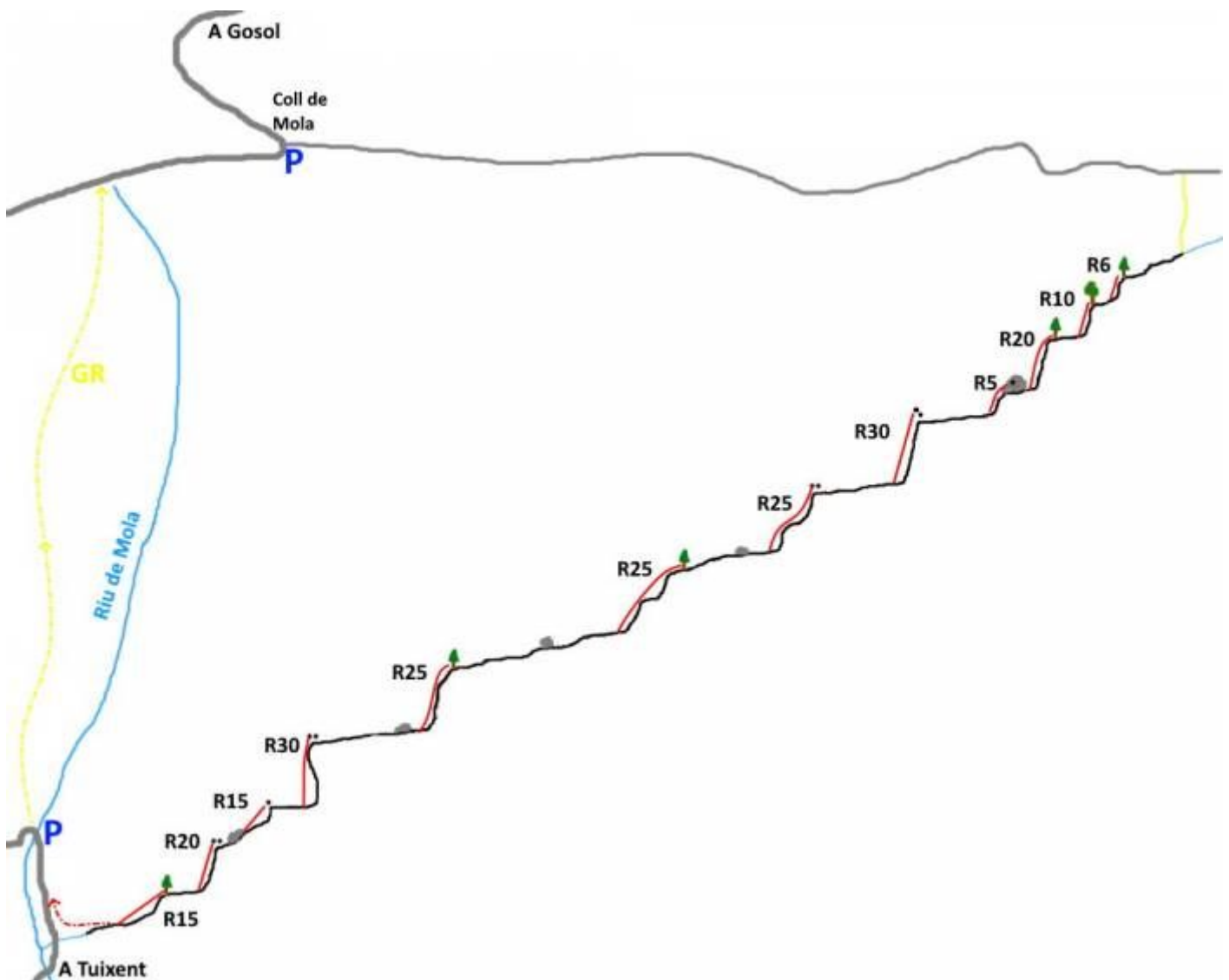
