Summary: (machine translated)

Long, rather open, alpine rappel canyon. The centerpiece is a 70m waterfall that can be seen from the L200.

Access: (machine translated)

From Dornbirn via Bödele into the Bregenzerwald and on to Mellau. Then park at the parking lot of the Mellau mountain railroad.

Approach: (machine translated)

Take the cable car up and head east towards Kanisalpe until you reach a bridge after just under 30 minutes. Now 2 minutes along the stream to the entry. On foot (without using the cable car) from the parking lot towards Kanisfluh, after 1500 m turn right towards Hofstätten. At Hofstätten turn right towards Mittagsspitze, then you come to the bridge described above (approx. 2 hours).

Tour: (machine translated)

The upper part has an alpine character, whereby an exit would be very difficult. At A1 it is recommended to build a Rappel Guide to the fixed ropes (steel rope). It is very slippery here and on the left you are pushed against the rock by the water. Advantageous with 2A Rappel. Bypass the A4 large block on the left then traverse to the right and build a rope traverse to the belay.the middle part is open and easy to walk on.exit options everywhere. The lower part begins where the canyon narrows again; the last emergency exit to the left is also possible here. After 4 rappels you come to the main section, the 70 m waterfall (wall book) which can be overcome with 2x rappels (10m/60m) or 3x rappels (10m/35m/30m). After another 4 abseils you reach the exit of the tour.

Return: (machine translated)

It is essential to pay attention to leave the streambed after about 300 m to the left (block) and follow an old path, later on the edge of the meadow to the goods road, then left back to the parking lot.

A really great alpine canyon which is, however, quite slippery. The ascent with the cable car (16,20€ as of 10.2025), the many high rappels, the great surroundings and 2 possible flat jumps make it really attractive. The anchors are good, but they are not always easy to follow and are more suitable for water-shy canyoneers. The canyon book is located directly in front of the high rappel and is easy to find. It should also be mentioned that one or two of the downclimbs are sporty. (machine translated)
