<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Interesting canyon (some people call it a collection canyon) if we take it after rains, with some water. It can be used for initiation to the rappel because they are simple, it usually always has a thread of water at the beginning (it can be avoided), that comes from the source of San Roque that is a little above.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) On the CV428 towards Cortes de Pallás, once past El Oro, before pk 4, in a right curve we will see an esplanade on the left with a sign "Vertedero". We park		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We will leave from here by a track that heads east, turns north and after 100m turns east again to now go down to the stream bed.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Quite boxed in and with beautiful formations. The rappels are easy except when there is water that can slip a little.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rappel the ravine opens up a little and we have a gully on the right to go up in search of some milestones that will take us to the electric tower. There we have a track that takes us to the road. By the road we went up to the parking lot. it could continue until almost the reservoir of the naranjero, and then return by a track to the car (hour and fifteen minutes). but it has no interest, are only destrepes and areas full of vegetation and reeds. only if you really like the adventure.

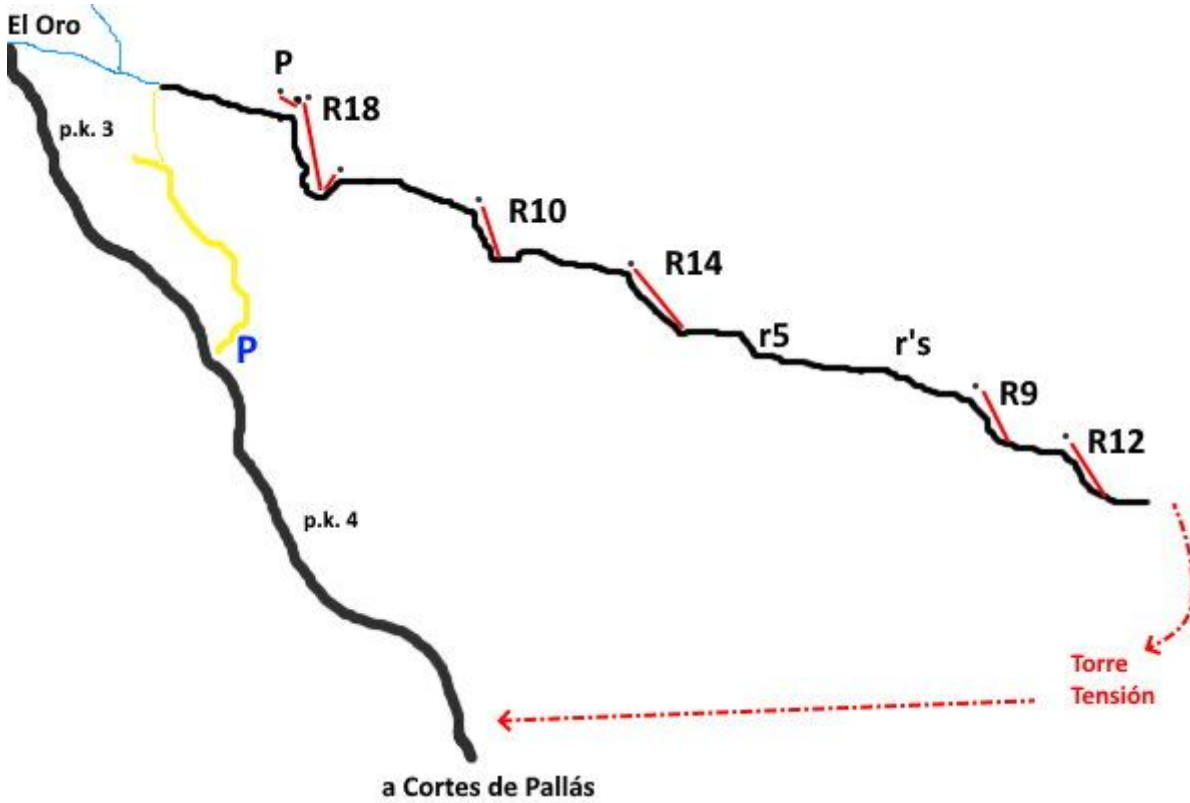
