Exciting rappel canyon over a 70m high waterfall

Approach via the B20. Between Mitterbach and Josefsberg a country road branches off in the direction of Erlaufklause/Bhf Erlaufklause. Follow this road (sand road in between) to the parking lot after the dam wall.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the marked hiking trail with number 622 via FH Hagengut and Jausenstation Ötscherhias into the Ötschergräben. From the Ötscherhias another 20 minutes along a beautiful path upstream to the Mirafall, visible from afar. Climb without a path and with difficulty over the steep forest and scree terrain to the east of the waterfall, at the top cross over a forest saddle into Mirabachtal.

Tour: (machine translated)

After a flat start, you come to a 15m high waterfall (tree on the left), followed shortly afterwards by a 30m waterfall (HSA on the left). After a few slides you stand in front of the 70m drop of the Mira Falls. About 4m behind the overhanging edge there is a chain, directly on the edge a single anchor. After about 30m of free-hanging abseiling, you have to swing to the next anchor (somewhat hidden at an angle). From this anchor it is another 45m abseil into the large pool under the waterfall. Caution: rope abseiling problems in the large waterfall, lots of loose rubble at the belay behind the waterfall (danger of falling rocks for tourists under the waterfall)
