Exciting rappel canyon over a 70m high waterfall

Approach via the B20. Between Mitterbach and Josefsberg a country road branches off in the direction of Erlaufklause/Bhf. Erlaufklause.\nThis follow (in between sand road) to the parking lot after the dam.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the marked hiking trail with number 622 via FH Hagengut and Jausenstation Ötscherhias into the Ötschergräben. From the Ötscherhias still 20min on a beautiful path upstream to the Mirafall visible from afar.\n\nWeglos and laboriously climb over the steep forest and Schrofen terrain east of the waterfall, at the top of a forest saddle into the Mirabachtal change.

Tour: (machine translated)

After a flat start you stand in front of a 15m high waterfall (tree on the left), a little later follows a 30m waterfall (HSA on the left).\nAfter some slides you stand in front of the 70m drop of the Mirafall.\nAbout 4m behind the overhanging drop edge there is a chain, directly at the edge a single anchor.\n\nAfter about 30m of free hanging slide you have to pendulum the next rappel point (a little bit hidden in the angle). From this anchor there is another 45m of rappelling into the big basin below the waterfall.\n\nCaution: rope pull problems in the big waterfall, lots of loose scree at the belaystation behind the waterfall (danger of falling rocks for the tourists below the waterfall).
