Forra sghiccio malvagna a3v2III In the same place a 2nd canyon (water-bearing) Clear canyon with 5 short abseils. You fight your way through the narrow streets of Malvagna to a monstrous road that leads down to Cascata Sghiccio. P 37.9215766N, 15.0606619E a few steps above at the exit of the road. This is the exit and a good place to check the water level. Follow the road back up and through the village to the cemetery. Another P 37.9205583N, 15.0566608E. Follow the closed road behind the cemetery until you come to an open building on the right. Sharp right along the forest road to a wire fence. Follow inside a ridge. Before the exit, take a sharp left back down the slope at an angle until you reach a pool. Entry 37.9270912N, 15.0621766E. Now follow the streambed for about 400m. Four cascades follow in quick succession. After another section of walking you reach the last and most beautiful abseiling point of the canyon, which leads into a double pool. 1. 12 m 2BH right, 1,BH left 2. 9 m 1BH+1SH left directly above the water line 3. 13 m 2 BH left into dry side arm 4. 8m 2BH left below trees 5. 7m 2BH left above under small wall Good equipment Exit possible at any time right or left Track at Wikiloc (machine translated)
