**Summary:** (machine translated)

A classic of El Valle, the stopover area. Perfect for its north orientation to give us the shade and be able to do it all year round. Simple, dry and with a very interesting final part.

Although it is accessed from Benferri, the bco belongs to the term of Orihuela.

**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

We are located in Benferri, on the A7 exit 545 (Orihuela/Benferri).

Take the CV870 (La Matanza) or the CV930 to Orihuela. Soon we turn off on the CV868 to La Matanza. At pk 4 we leave on the right the detour to La Matanza and 20m later we have the detour to the left to El Valle/vallecito (Los Yagües detour). We take this small road that passes under the highway and after a few meters we have a pond on our left and a place to park.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We will continue walking towards the next pond from where a PR starts that zigzags us up to the top of the mountain range. Once up the path forks, we will take to the right towards the head of our ravine. Just when the pines are running out on our right we will leave the path to go into the riverbed.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

A very easy first part up to the rappel from the bush to access the head of R25. From here it is a vertical and vertiginous descent.

**Return:** (machine translated)

We continue along the ravine to the pond, then we will have a path to go north to the car.

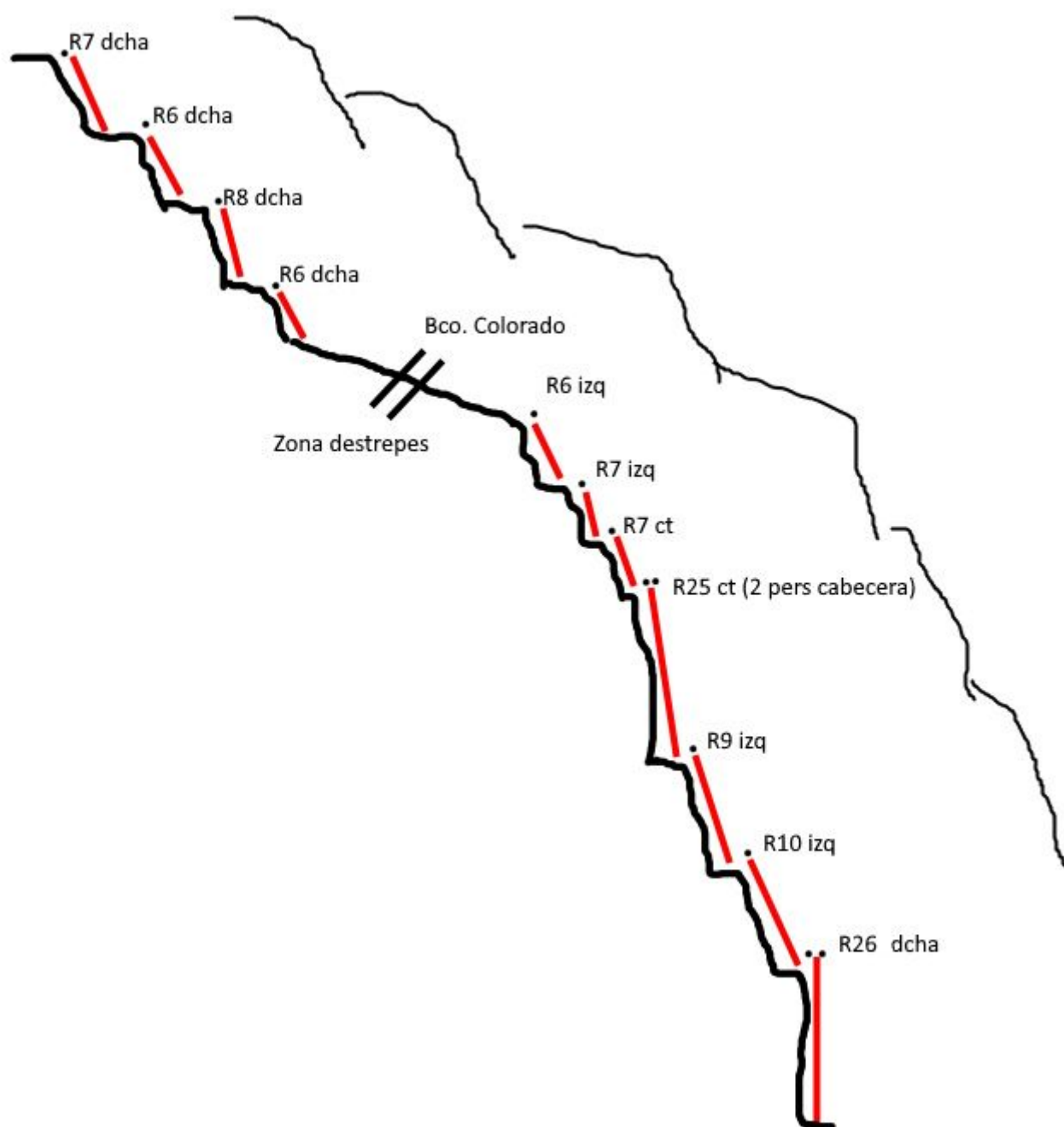
