<b>Gear:</b> Ropes: (2x40m/ 1x20m)		
<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Very nice rather open canyon with clean water; grippy limestone; lots of gravel and boulders (also in the pool); some sharp edges; several tributaries therefore only in stable weather; steep descent; no cell phone reception; no emergency exit; south-facing; longer walking passages.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) approx. 30min Freeway exit Slovenia. Direction Bovec --> shortly after the Italian-Slovenian mountain border (Predil Pass) at the war memorial (sleeping lion) is the parking lot for the entry --> the shuttle car is parked a few km further, under the bridge on the left before the village Log Pod Mangartom at about 600Hm.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) approx. 15min At the war memorial the steep path right behind the wall upwards (!!! Slippery) --> at the beginning there is no real path recognizable --> further down you meet a forest path that you follow left briefly until you descend at a suitable point further steeply in the direction of the stream sound. If you have chosen a good route, you don't need ropes to get into the stream --> entry at about 900Hm at a short flatter place.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) approx. 4-5h Arrived in the streambed you walk for some time through stony terrain with several small slides --> up to the first rappel point (where you also have the possibility for entry) --> the first rappels with approx. 15 and 20m are unproblematic, but watch out for sharp edges --> the rappel points are mostly in the course of the water and the pools are often not visible --> at C32 you can rappel right and left (R32) --> small climbing passages --> about 500m walking --> after that the canyon becomes more incised. Small rappels, slides, jumps follow --> the last rappels in the canyon are not to be underestimated --> narrows, slippery passages and the last high step still requires good touring --> the last rappel can also be subdivided --> then you walk a good 1km to the road bridge.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) approx. 0min At the bridge at about 600Hm you can get off either right or left.

Access parking lot coordinates start directly at the hiking trail (at approx. 1100 hm) and are therefore not at the war memorial, where the description begins. You can still find your way down superiore, although we probably followed the hiking trail a bit too far and thus got on directly at the 15 rappel. The approach time was still 15 minutes. Tour as a whole superiore, great for walking, only in the rappels partly slippery. Rappels mostly in the water but with today's water level absolutely zero problems. Despite Sunday no other tour encountered. Stands Obergourmet chains with partly 3 glued anchors. Were with access to 4. in 03:45 at the car down. Started the tour at 10:20 am and had perfect sunshine in the canyon, we even got quite hot throughout. More of a rappel and walking tour with only a few low possible jumps. (machine translated)

I'd say it's more of a V4A3 canyon. It has an upper and a lower part and both can be completed separately, together it is a full day hike. The start of the upper part is really hard to find, there are some beautiful abseils, then a longer walk before the lower part starts. The lower part is without emergency exits, mostly abseiling, all in great conditions. The last abseiling is a bit tricky, we did it with a traverse line plus abseiling, it can be abseiled along the entire length with a longer rope.
