<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Very beautiful, rather open canyon with clean water; grippy limestone; lots of gravel and scree (also in the pool); some sharp edges; several tributaries therefore only in stable weather; steep descent; no cell phone reception; no emergency exit; south-facing; longer walking passages.  To visit Predelica, a permit application must be submitted to the National Park. And this permit must also be paid for. <b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Highway exit Slovenia. Direction Bovec --> after 1.5km after the Italian-Slovenian mountain border (Predilpass) is the parking lot (Mangart) for the entry --> the shuttle car is parked a few km further, under the bridge left before the village Log Pod Mangartom at about 600Hm.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot, cross the road and walk about 20m in a northerly direction. There is a gap in the guard rails. Here a clearly visible path leads to the entry (approx. 10min).		

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Once in the streambed, walk for some time through rocky terrain with several small slides and jumps

-> to the first abseil point 8m anchor right

\*8m anchor left

\* 12m anchor right

\*22m anchor left

\* 30m anchors left and right

Exit first canyon

\* approx. 500m walking passages

\*14m anchor left

\*D4

\*4m under rock, anchor behind rock

\*J3m

\*12m anchor left

\*J5m

\*MC 14m anchor right

\*4m anchor left

\*10m anchor right

\*4m anchor right

\*J3m

\*25m anchor left

43m standing in two

Access parking lot coordinates start directly at the hiking trail (at approx. 1100 m) and are therefore not at the war memorial, where the description begins. You can still find your way down superiore, although we probably followed the hiking trail a bit too far and thus got on directly at the 15 rappel. The approach time was still 15 minutes. Tour as a whole superiore, great for walking, only in the rappels partly slippery. Rappels mostly in the water but absolutely no problems with today's water level. Despite Sunday no other tour encountered. Stands Obergourmet chains with partly 3 glued anchors. Were with access to 4. in 03:45 at the car down. Started the tour at 10:20 am and had perfect sunshine in the canyon, we even got quite hot throughout. More of a rappel and walking tour with only a few low possible jumps. Only allowed with prior authorization plus national park fee. (machine translated)

I'd say it's more of a V4A3 canyon. It has an upper and a lower part and both can be completed separately, together it is a full day hike. The start of the upper part is really hard to find, there are some beautiful abseils, then a longer walk before the lower part starts. The lower part is without emergency exits, mostly abseiling, all in great conditions. The last abseiling is a bit tricky, we did it with a traverse line plus abseiling, it can be abseiled along the entire length with a longer rope.
