<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Beautiful granite rock with good grip, but again and again individual slippery passages; EWZ call +41 (0) 818243434 (but show little interest); check water level; stands partly exposed; many rappel; no known emergency exit; cold water; 2 siphons.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) approx. 0h Drive into the village of Bondo --> follow the signs to the campsite --> cross the small bridge (=Bondasca Canyon) --> park in front of the campsite on the left --> (commuting possible but not necessary as you only have 30min ascent and the use of the mountain road costs € 9,-).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) approx. 30min From the parking lot (approx. 840Hm) take the hiking trail at the signpost on the left up into the forest until you reach the road --> here further signposting --> (if you take the road on the right here, you can look into the canyon at the bridge) --> from the signposting cross the road --> hiking trail further up until you meet the road for the 2nd time --> follow this road until you reach a barrier --> here go downhill to the bridge below the dam wall --> entry approx. 1080Hm.		

**Tour:** (machine translated)

approx. 3,5-4,5h

At the bridge you rappel 20m over the railing into the canyon --> short walking passages over washed out streambed --> E2 over rock --> walking passage with iron girder in the rock --> walking passage over flat passage in the pool --> E over boulders and water channel approx. 8m --> walking passage to a big boulder which can be bypassed on the right (downclimb) --> short swimming passage --> walking and downclimbing passage to the 1st R15 (right) in pool --> walking and climbing passage (2m) --> step 4m on the left bypassable resp. climbable (E3) --> then you see the stone bridge --> just to the left there is a C25 piton in a narrower part of the gorge (the last meters can also be jumped into the pool) --> short walking and climbing passage to the left single bolts R5 in narrow swimming passage --> canyon becomes a bit wider --> short walking and climbing passage (right rock with trees, here possibly emergency exit) --> left bolts (! here do not rappel completely, but stone slab up to the left to the optimal place for rope retrieval. Without traverse 99% rope jamming) for traverse (15m) at large sloping stone slab + R20 (last meters jump in large pool --> after the pool R4 (r.) at large boulder --> R5 (li.) or E5 --> then you come to a huge freestanding boulder with large tree, this r. R10 (r.) cascade into small pool --> R15 (r.) in overhang and big hollow --> S2 into big pool (very nice place) --> short climbing passage (E) in watercourse --> 2 clamping blocks (siphons) which can also be bypassed r. short walk in the watercourse to R6 (right) or S6 in the pool --> C15 (right) (! very slippery) --> left bolts for rope traverse ca. 10m to belaystation R28 (left) in big pools --> r. Drill hook for 20m slippery sloping slab to 2nd belaystation R10 over sloping stone slab --> small pools and R20 (left) in large pools --> approx. 150m walking passages over rock and stone to left stone house (exit left) --> right over bridge to parking lot.

**Return:** (machine translated)

approx. 2min

At the stone house left across small grassy area to the road --> right across the bridge to the parking lot.
