From Bern or Zurich to Sorbach, see approach in photo gallery.\nPark your car there on the parking lot on the Emme next to the bridge for exit.\n\nWith the second car up the Emme towards Schangnau. Parking lot at Räben, cf. implementation in photo gallery.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the car, descend the dirt road for about 150m along the Emme River, then turn right onto the gravel bed before the gorge begins.

Tour: (machine translated)

After the beginning of the gorge, mainly swimming sections at the beginning. The natural bridge - the Räbloch - may be blocked by driftwood. First (emergency) exit possibility then left out over the Chnubelhüttengraben. From here mainly hiking route to the bridge at Bächleren.

Aquatic

The catchment area is huge and upcoming thunderstorms in the canyon are often not noticeable.

During thunderstorms the Emme can swell up to over 100 m³/sec in a matter of minutes and make it impossible to escape.

The current water level of the Emme at Eggiwil can be found on the FOEN website at www.hydrodaten.admin.ch/d/2409.htm.

Ideal water quantity approx. 3.0 m³/sec. From

5.0 m³ per second the Emme becomes quite turbulent in some places.

Watch out for bouncing water and undercutting along the rock walls. When at the natural bridge the Emme is covered with driftwood, this bottleneck becomes a key point!

Before this bridge out to the right and on the right bank the path to Sorbach. There left across the Emme to the lower car.
