<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Short, beautiful tour; be sure to check the water level beforehand; reservoir above; can be done as a single tour or in combination with Vajo dell'Orsa superiore.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Torbole --> highway direction Verona/Affi --> exit at or before Brentino --> drive into the village of Brentino (located above the main road and the water canal) --> in the village follow the road to the right to the old power station (ENEL) (first asphalt then gravel) --> at the exit of the dead end you are in front of the iron gate of the beautiful old hydroelectric power station --> park here (approx. 280Hm).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the ENEL power station via the hiking trail left up to the stream --> you can check the water level beforehand at the exit below the key point (clamping block) (350Hm).		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) You can do the lower part of the Vajo dell'Orsa as a short introductory tour or do the very rewarding combination with part 1 (see description Vajo dell'Orsa superiore) --> if you decide to do the lower part only, after a short walking passage you go straight to the 1st abseiling point of 10m --> this is immediately followed by a 12m section slightly overhanging in deep pools + a small jump into the next pool --> after the next 5m step with large pools you come to the 1st abseiling point of 10m --> immediately afterwards there is a 12m section slightly overhanging in deep pools + a small jump into the next pool. After a short walking passage you go straight to the first rappel point of 10m --> immediately afterwards there is a 12m point slightly overhanging in deep pools + small jump into the next pool --> after the next 5m step with large pools comes the last rappel point --> here you can rappel left from the clamping block to a clear chain anchor or you can rappel directly in the water course below the clamping block (!!!rock in the arrival pool!!!) after a short walking section you leave the canyon right (290Hm).		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Follow the clearly visible path back to the parking lot at the ENEL power station.

A great short canyon, the zip line is a highlight and there are nice rappels in the water. There are some indications of commercial use. (Caution: pure conjecture!) When it comes to finding the way, there are many paths to be found thanks to the climbing routes. We went as described to the last crossing, where a tree with a white triangle marks the opposite side (here it is best to follow the stream directly in the direction of the river to the first rappel, if you look upstream you will find the narrow point), and followed the path to the last rappel of the upper part, which is just a run. The aforementioned narrow section offers some compensation here, but you don't need to go all the way to the back (and over the rocks)!
