From the GC_1 (Las Palmas - Maspalomas) we turn off onto the GC_10 to Telde, which is also a 4-lane road. We drive through Telde on this road to its exit. Here we turn left onto the GC_41, come to Valsequillo and continue to Las Vegas. After this town, the GC_10 turns northwest. About 200 m after this right turn, we turn left onto a small paved road. After another 300 m, we reach the Bco. de los Mocanes and park the car in a small bay just before the streambed. With a four-wheel drive vehicle, you could drive up the access described below to the point where you descend into the streambed at the top.

Approach: (machine translated)

Beyond the barranco we climb the path continuously. We pass a saddle and arrive at the houses, where we are greeted by the fierce barking of dogs (Jan. 2009; up to here about 4.5 km). We continue along the track, ignoring a forest path leading into the Bco. on the right, and finally come out of the sparse pine forest into a high valley (approx. 1210 m a.s.l. - 6.5 km from the parking lot). Here we descend an indistinct path to the streambed and immediately encounter the first rappel.

9 rappel. The remarkable thing about this Bco. in basalt rock is its bright green color (see photos) the canyon has several parts with the following names (from top to bottom): Canada de Botija - Bco. del Chorro -Bco. de los Mocanes

Return: (machine translated)

About 100 m after the last wide 8 m drop, which you bypass to the right - for lack of anchors - you meet a large boulder. Under this, a water pipe leads along, which you follow (somewhat herbaceous), until you can go down on the broad ridge orographic. left of the barranco a - partly indistinct - path. Subsequently, one meets a little road that leads us directly to the car.
