Summary: (machine translated) Alpine, gloomy and watery glacier gorge. May only be climbed after prior reservation by telephone 0041 33 855 32 32 and in the period 15.11 - 15.12 and 10.01 - 15.03. Can be combined with Trümmelbach IV and/or Trümmelbach III by very fit groups.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Coming from Bern we leave the A8 via exit 25 - Wilderswil and take the road south to Lauterbrunnen.\nFrom there we continue towards Stechelberg. 3.3 km (calculated from the train station, parking garage) after Lauterbrunnen we come to the large parking lots at the restaurant Trümmelbach. Please do NOT park here, but continue for about 2km until you reach the large parking lots of the Stechelberg cable car on the left.		
Approach: (machine translated) On the road 25min back in the direction of the canyon (a post bus leaves every 30min), before you reach the tourist parking lot at the restaurant turn right onto an access road and continue on the hiking trail in the direction of Wengen. We come after many, partly secured serpentines to the bridge over the Trümmelbach (entry).		

Tour: (machine translated)

Just over 20 rappels in a mostly gloomy atmosphere, sometimes in complete darkness. Anchors mostly only monopoint.

At the highest waterfall there is an intermediate belay after about 35m RG behind the wall at head height.

Important! Letter of intent from October 2017 between Kaspar von Almen AG and the Swiss Mountain Guide Association SBV.

The most important points:

Canyoning is only permitted outside the operating and opening hours of the von Almen AG facility!

The von Almen AG facility is generally closed from November 15 to December 15 and from January 10 to March 15. Canyoning is permitted during these periods by prior arrangement.

Tours can only be arranged by telephone in advance on +41 33 855 32 32. This number provides information about the specific opening times and work on the gorge facilities.

The paths, footbridges, bridges and tunnels of von Almen AG may not be used. Emergency situations are reserved.

The exit from the canyon is only possible on the left-hand side of the stream (direction of flow) after the last waterfall.

The replacement of abseiling hooks is permitted. New installations may only be installed with the consent of von Almen AG.

The canyon is rated v5a5V and is therefore reserved for very experienced canyoneers!

Von Almen AG accepts no liability for accidents in connection with canyoning.

We ask all canyoneers to adhere strictly to the above points! In the event of non-compliance by individual persons, von Almen AG reserves the right to terminate the declaration of intent and to prohibit canyoning in the canyon.

Camping and parking in the area of the Trümmelbach Falls is prohibited.

Canyoneers are requested to use the parking lot at the cable car before Stechelberg!

Return: (machine translated)

Where we reach the wide streambed, out left and along the edge of the forest to the access path. Take this back to the road and continue to the car
