Summary: (machine translated)

After a rappel, you reach the bed of the Vilacireres river, where a very beautiful part with rappels in a canyon begins, all of which are less than 20 m high and require no breaks.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Parking lot below Berga. Take the road to Sant Llorenç de Morunys and then turn right towards La Corriu. Just before La Corriu (4.5 km from the road), turn right towards Santuari de Puigaguila. After 900 m you will see the starting point of the return route. Park there.

Parking on the mountain: Continue uphill for 6.5 km on the main road. (After 2 km, the road turns into a dirt road.) From the parking lot on the mountain, take the paths on the left bank of the river and descend to the right to the normally dry riverbed of the Bco Can Pelegri. Path down until you see water.

Approach: (machine translated)

The canyon of Vilacireres can be descended separately, but it is better to enter via the Barranco de Can Pelegri. This avoids a less interesting start. Can Pelegri ends exactly where the series of incised rappels from Vilacireres begins.

A very beautiful descent, the most interesting in the Berga area after the Pas de l'Escalèll. The only downside is the long way back.

From the upper parking lot, follow the paths on the left bank of the river and down to the right to the normally dry riverbed of the Bco Can Pelegri. You descend until the water becomes visible.

Tour: (machine translated)

The highest waterfall is 30 m high, but you'd better have two 40-meter ropes with you to get all the way down. After a rappel, you reach the Vilacireres riverbed, where a very beautiful part with rappels in a canyon begins, all of which are less than 20 m high and require no breaks.

Return: (machine translated)

At the end, there is a long part of hiking and descent until you reach the return path. Leave the right bank of the river and climb up to the viewpoint of the "Ruta dels Cims"; from there, continue to the road.

There is another way back, but it requires a long drive and does not save any time.
