According to a letter from the LRA Rosenheim: The owner of the land has spoken out against canyoning on site and the Schoßbach is located in a biotope worthy of protection. Dedication of the area in accordance with Art. 18 Para. 3 BayWG has already failed, primarily due to nature conservation concerns, the lack of consent from the owner and the lack of consent from the municipality of Aschau i. Ch. Canyoning in the Schoßbach is therefore not permitted.

Ropes: 2x80m

Forest canyon that exits with an 80m waterfall

We leave the freeway A8 - Munich-Salzburg - at the exit Frasdorf and drive on the St2093 about 3.5 km southwards to Aschau im Chiemgau. Continue on the St2093 to the south. After 1.7 km we pass the center of Hohenaschau, 2.2 km further on we see the houses of the hamlet Außerwald (farm Auerhof) on the left side of the road. A good 100 m further on, we turn right off the St2093 and cross the Prien River. Now we go about 200 m through the forest, at the junction at the edge of the forest we keep left. Now we look for a suitable place to park our car.\n\nIf we have a second car available, we drive it along the St2093 for another 1 km and then turn right onto the road to Schoßbrinn, which is closed to through traffic. Here we look for a suitable place for the car for the exit.

We walk along the road where we parked the (possibly first) car, first in a south-westerly direction, then after a bend in the road in a north-westerly direction. After a few meters, a forest path branches off to the left, which we take. We cross a wildlife protection fence and follow the path that runs towards the Schoßbach stream. Where the path turns right to the Ellandalm, we take the path straight ahead and continue towards the Schoßbach. The hunters path is partly dilapidated, but it takes us directly to the entry point (where it crosses the Schoßbach). You can also climb further down to access the final waterfall directly; the entry point would then be where the hunters path allows access to the streambed for the first time (900 m altitude).

Tour: (machine translated)

Some smaller rappels, some steps for downclimbing, in between also walking passages lead us to the Schoßbrinn waterfall. A handrail leads to the belaystation, from which it then goes 80 m downhill on a free slope.

Return: (machine translated)

First along the Schoßbach in an easterly direction, then left in a northerly direction to the road leading from the St2093 to the houses of Schoßbrinn. If we have parked a second car at the described place, now on the road to the right and after 270 m we come to this car at the St2093. But if we have left our only car at Einfang, we cross the tarred road and follow the road to the north until we reach our car.
