Simple ravine in the north of the island, next to San Felipe. We can park at the top, at the bottom in San Felipe or even combine vehicles to save a little bit of walking.

By the GC2, by the north of the island

We can leave at exit 20 to take the GC291 or exit 15 also towards GC291 or GC751 to San Felipe.

Location of San Felipe ravines

Parking at the top, on the GC291, at km 5.4 just at the right curve with the track to the Valerón reservoir.

If we want to park below we will go to San Felipe by the GC751 until the end, we can go up the street Diseminado de San Felipe in search of a lay-by where to park although it is usually very frequented by climbers.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access to bcos Valerón, Calabozo, Silva and Guayarmina

From the top it is very simple, we have the rings on the other side of the road.

From below by the street Diseminado de San Felipe we approach the base of the bridge of the highway, arriving we will find a path on the right "Camino de San Felipe" where we will go up until we reach the height of the highway, we leave the path and we go left to the road GC291. We will have to walk almost 1km along the road and it is very narrow so be very careful.
