Summary: (machine translated) Short but beautiful swimming passages in the Mitterweißenbach. It is often used by kayakers (although they do this in spring when there is plenty of water). However, the passage is only safe for canyoneers at low water! Various anchors and fixed ropes are available to (partially) bypass the critical points. Not without danger at higher water levels!		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) By car on the Westautobahn exit at Regau, just before Bad Ischl a road branches off in the direction of Weißenbach am Attersee. Follow this road for about 4km until you see a parking lot with a small chapel on the left side of the road. Park here.		
Approach: (machine translated) Descend at the bridge over the Höllbach.		
Tour: (machine translated) With the help of two fixed ropes you descend into the Weißenbach. After swimming through a few pools, you reach a 2m jump. After that, a short walking section is followed by a 3m slide and again a few pools.		
Return: (machine translated) Get off on the left side and hike back on a small trail along the canyon.		
Coordinates: Canyon Start 47.7673 13.6363 Parking Entry and Exit 47.7668 13.6378 Canyon End 47.7666 13.6387

There are no longer any fixed ropes at the entry; you'll need a rope for this, but otherwise it's a nice swim. Total time required: max. 20 min. As a bonus to the Burggrabenklamm Only worth doing as a second canyon (machine translated)

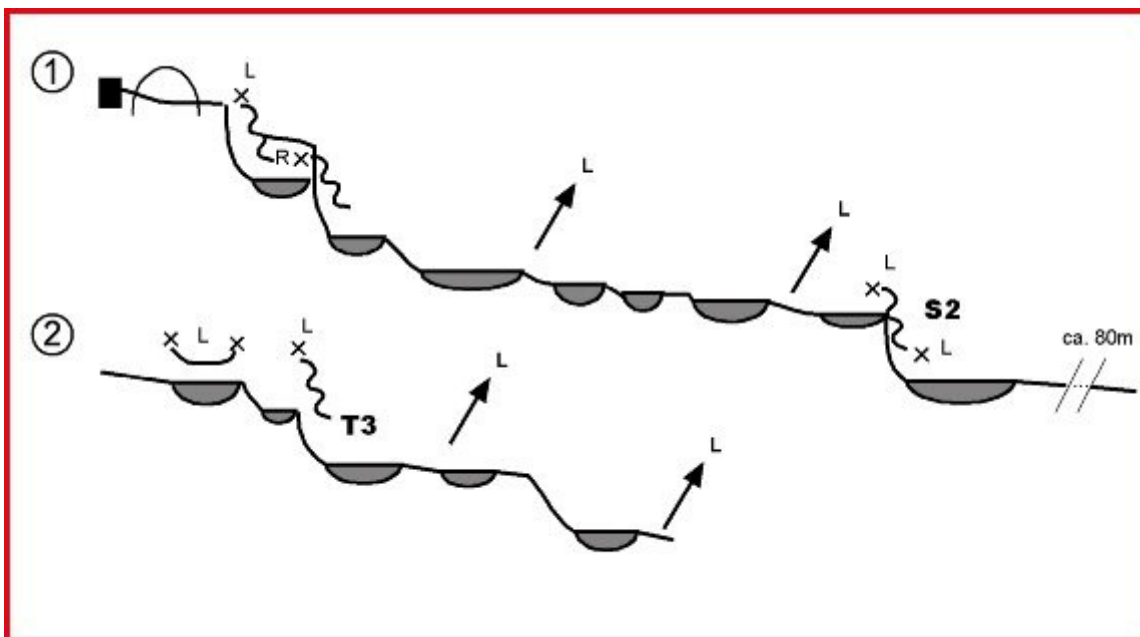
Kayak section for swimming down. There are good stands in front of the waterfalls to swim to and jump over the whitewater elements. Pools were all deep and free with me. (machine translated)
