Summary: (machine translated) Nice ravine although forgotten for not being as spectacular as others in the area. Much better in spring, after rains with good flow, in summer it dries out.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We must be located on the N260 between Castejón de Sos and Laspaúles. At the Coll de Fadas at pk 375 we have the detour to San Feliú de Veri. When we reach San Feliú we have the detour to La Muria on the left, we follow this winding road at the foot of the Turbón, leaving La Muria to one side and down to the river just to the recreation area, where we will park.		
Approach: (machine translated) After 20 minutes and before a sharp bend to the right, we will see the stream and the entrance to the ravine on the left.		
Tour: (machine translated) Simple canyon with only 4 rappels of up to 15m to complete the day or to initiate people.		
Return: (machine translated) We will arrive at the recreational area
