Short rappel canyon; well suited for beginners as there are no major difficulties. Therefore, intensive commercial ascent.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Coming from Bilbao on the highway, we continue past Santander in the direction of Gijon / Oviedo. Leave the highway at Unquera and turn onto the N-621 towards Potes. Pass Oanes and follow the Rio Deva upstream. About 2-3 km after Hermida - you now have the Rio Deva on your right - the Navedo comes down from the left (east), shortly after the marker 'km 161'. Here you should look for a suitable parking space on the road, which is particularly busy during vacations and weekends.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the road, the trail leads up the orographic left bank. This opens up good views of the not very deep canyon. After about 20 min. a 'bridge' leads over the creek. Here is the entry

**Tour:** (machine translated)

At most rappelling points there are alternative rappelling stands, so that 'overtaking' is possible. There are some smaller toboggans, you should avoid jumps (own painful experience at the first rappelling point!). Continuous exit possibility to the left onto the ascent path.

**Return:** (machine translated)

About 20 m before reaching the road bridge, turn left onto the ascent path to the N-621.
