Access: (machine translated)

From the Barcelona - Tarragona - Valencia highway, turn off onto the N-234 towards Teruel approx. 25 km before Valencia at Sagunto. After about 80 km you will reach the village of La Pueblo de Valverde, which is located slightly to the right off the road. Turn left here (southwest) towards Camarena de la Sierra (16 km). In Camarena, keep half-left towards (Monte) Javalambre (2020 m), and at the end of the village there are some orientation signs on the right. At the first crossroads after leaving the village, take the road on the right ('Salto de Amanaderos'). 8.5 km after Camarena, at a picnic area with a spring ('Fuente de Matahombres'), take the dirt road to the right. Follow this for another 4.5 km, then the track crosses the stream and you are immediately at the entry point (road sign 'Riodeva' on the right)

This is also a good place to spend the night. The track was easy to drive on.

30 m from parking lot

Tour: (machine translated)

7 rappel. Little cut canyon at the northern foot of the Javalambre, with beautiful tuff waterfalls, partly mossy, should also have water in dry seasons.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last major rappel point, the streambed flattens and the canyon widens. Here you keep (orographically) half-left, climb diagonally up the slope and meet the long-distance hiking path GR-8 about 20 m above the stream. On this path you return to the starting point with beautiful views of the canyon.
