Some bolts are a bit awkwardly placed. In some cases an anchor must be used for more than 1 drop, which is not always evident or logical (risk of stuck ropes). Currently extremely slippery, which made reaching some of the anchors quite difficult and slowed progress. We used the last exit (bridge, path to Gimmelwald) because it was getting dark. Very varied in terms of abseil height and aquatics. Already nicely iced up after the 70. You don't need crampons and ice tools yet. The lower part is slippery due to light moss. The middle section was a welcome warm change in the sun around 12 o'clock. Have set a new anchor for the traverse rope to the 70er. (machine translated)
