<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Scenic and varied dry canyon with cave crossing		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Take the SS125 to Baunei and in the town follow a winding but well-maintained road towards Ristorante del Golgo. After about 9km the asphalt road ends, here continue on a bumpy, narrow sand road towards Cala Sisine. After 6.8km at an information sign turn right towards Ololbizzi where after about 200m you will find various parking facilities.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot on a road towards the sea, a bend is shortened over a gravel field. Descend a little in the bottom of the trench until you reach the first abseil point.  Alternatively and more beautifully, you can also climb along the orographic right canyon rim via the ridge. The ridge soon becomes a rocky ridge. Via climbing tracks and easy scrambling, you bypass the first small drop-off before reaching the first abseil point at the exit of the ridge.		

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Access via canyon: rappel 8m from the left, walk briefly and rappel 25m from the chain anchor on the right. After another short downclimb, leave the bottom of the gorge to the right on indistinct trails and cross a boulder field. Descend briefly and continue towards a high, reddish wall (striking rock towers above). This is the upper entrance to the Sa Rutta de Su Tentorgiu passage cave.

**Access via the ridge:**

4 abseils from bolt stands or tree abseils. Abseil sequence 20m, 10m, 27m and 30m. The last abseil point exits directly above the cave. You can also rappel the first two rappels in one. Short walking passages in the scree between abseiling points 2-3 and 3-4. Do not kick any stones loose.

**Common course:**

Rappel 8m from anchors on the right (do not descend into the shaft), crawl left briefly and ascend briefly in the following stalactite-lined passage. Then downclimb the following 10m steps or rappel from one of the stalactites. Then downclimb again to reach the lower exit of the cave. Rappel 13m from anchors on the right, follow a path to the left and rappel another 10m to reach the transverse Selvaggio Blu Trekking 'path'. Turn left into the rock gate and rappel 15m or cross even further over wedged juniper trunks to the left and downclimb (Sardinian via ferrata). Descend briefly in the streambed you have reached again to rappel 30m from the tree or from the belay directly in the wall to the penultimate ledge directly above the Mediterranean. Caution - do not rappel onto the lowest ledge -> dead end.

From the rock ledge you can reach the tourist cave Grotta del Fico - head south through the cave (15m possible jumps into the Mediterranean from the middle rock window), then cross over a fixed rope with difficulty to the cave entrance - the cave is regularly visited by tourist boats in the high season. **Return:** (machine translated)

At the penultimate rocky ledge, cross to the north. Where the ledge narrows, descend along a thin wire rope to a juniper trunk with steps. With the help of the juniper trunk, downclimb over a small overhang and over boulders into the bay. In the cove, pass a narrow, high cave and 50m after that, ascend to the left over a reddish, crumbly wall - the path reveals itself after the first 15 meters of altitude. Briefly ascend to the right, then follow the climbing tracks in an arc into the forest cove directly above the cove. In the southern corner of this forest cove, wedged juniper trunks help you over a smooth wall, then about 50hm of easy climbing until you are back on easier terrain. From here, always follow the stone markers to get back to the parking lot (path correctly entered in openstreetmap). Do not follow the blue colored dots to the right

A scenic tour with varied elements, a car with ground clearance is recommended for the access road (our Renault Kangoo was fine). The access via the ridge was not easy to find, but once on the tour you quickly find your way around. We almost missed the last rappel because we expected 30m, but it was shorter. When rappelling, just watch out for the cave entrance with fixed ropes. (machine translated)

Great tour! At the exit of the long slope there is a large parking lot with a bar, which you wouldn't expect to see on the approach. You can even spend the night there. There are also showers. There are two options at the last anchor. The one on the right probably leads directly into the sea, which is a shame if you don't have a boat to pick you up. The one on the left by the tree leads to the described plateau right by the sea. (machine translated)
