Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful lime canyon with several mostly short abseils, some jumps and slides. When the water level is high, the tour should not be underestimated due to the narrow passages. There are two entry points via the "Ciol della Val" tributary		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From the village of Claut, drive to Lesis. Either park at the first free parking lot (approx. 10 min. walk to P2) or shortly after Lesis cross the Cellina bridge and drive to the large second parking lot (until the third Sunday in Sept. you have to pay €6/car for parking at P2 -> parking machine at P1 with CE card function).		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow path 391 over the first bridge and continue orographically to the right of the Ciolesan up to an alpine meadow with several houses. Turn left at the first house (markings and path difficult to see). Then climb steeply and keep left up to the edge of the forest. Continue steeply uphill on a visible path with many hairpin bends. After a few meters in altitude, the narrow, sometimes very exposed path with little difference in altitude runs parallel and far above the canyon until you reach the "Ciol della Val" tributary. (Alternatively, after crossing a mostly dry streambed, you can branch off to the left and follow an unmarked path - this path first leads to the ruins of an old material cable car, then steeply down to the Ciol della Val streambed, which you reach 3 abseiling points before the confluence with the Ciolesan. This access saves you 5 abseils from the upper Ciol della Val).		
Tour: (machine translated) To reach the Ciolesan, descend via the open (sunny) tributary "Ciol della Val". Depending on the entry option, there are 8 or 3 (max. 30m) abseils to the confluence with the Ciolesan. The lime canyon is very varied and continuous. From the confluence with the Ciolesan it becomes narrower and more spectacular. Here there are a further 8 abseiling points (max. 15m). The sometimes very narrow (0.5m) and mostly short rappels should not be underestimated, especially at higher water levels. In the lower part of the last narrow passage there is a large clamping block that apparently blocks the way. However, this can usually be bypassed on the left without any major problems. After this, there is a veil shower and a small abseil step before you leave the canyon on the left. In 2023, the entire tour (16 abseiling points) was equipped with Inox chain anchors and wing rings as well as several helpful rope traverses (still in place in 2025!). However, the emergency drill set should always be carried as the canyon can change quickly after a flood. All in all, a worthwhile tour with beautiful mountain scenery (tip: a dinosaur footprint can be visited nearby).		
Return: (machine translated) As the streambed opens up, you will see a water line stretched across the canyon. Exit here to the left and follow the water pipe along a clear path that leads back to the parking lot
