Summary: (machine translated) Dry canyon except after heavy rains. Although in some guides it is marked as an initiation canyon, the facilities are somewhat exposed and you have to be a little careful, it would be rather a good place to practice with someone who has already done some other canyon. It will allow us to make guided, fraccionamientos, recoverable handrails, Being a not too long canyon we can combine it with the Via Ferrata de la Mulatica.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We must get to Andilla. By the CV35 to the exit of Villar del Arzobispo CV395. At the traffic circle of the CV345, next to the village of Villar, we will go to it and then continue towards the CV341 to Andilla. Once in Andilla we will have to go towards the Fuente del Señor. In the recreational area we will park.		
Approach: (machine translated) We will leave by the GR (path on the left) leaving on our right the path to the Via Ferrata de la Mulatica. When you reach the signpost (about 2kms) turn right towards Canales. We will continue along this section of the GR until we reach the riverbed of the ravine where we will follow it.		
Tour: (machine translated) Easy descent with almost all rappels avoidable except R3 and R4. At the end we can make the via ferrata of La Mulatica and a little further down to ride a zip line or guided over the fountain (we must carry badges).		
Return: (machine translated) Immediately towards the parking lot, it is the same return of the ferrata.

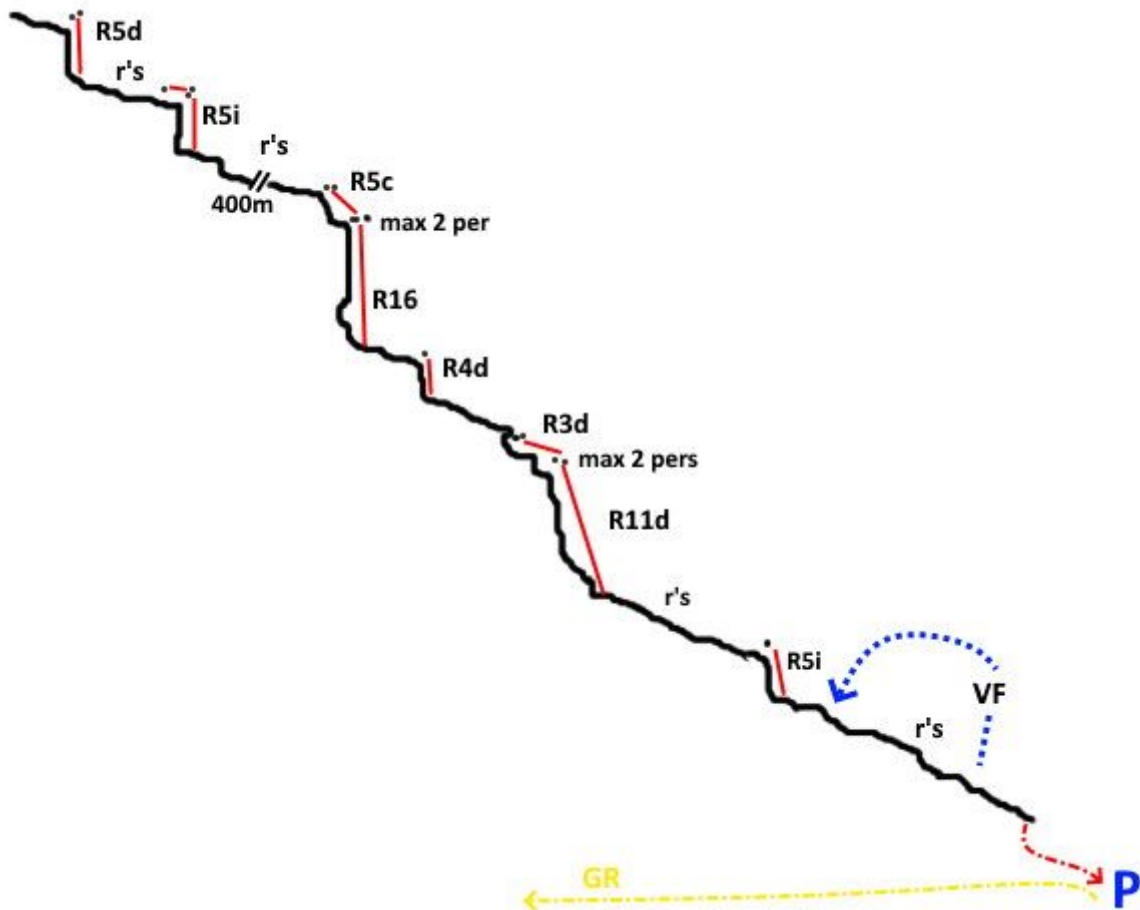
