Nice but dry ravine, except for heavy rains, in which we can even find a cave in the middle of the descent. Short but very dressed, it is not superfluous to take the pruning shears.

With a car:

Leaving Sant Llorenç de Morunys on the LV-4241 towards Berga until you find at the p.k. 42,6 on the left the Sisquer-Montcalb signpost, which we will take. We will pass the hermitage of Sant Esteve de Sisquer and after almost 6 kilometers we will find a track on the left towards the Parera and the Molí de la Corriu. Continue along the track until you reach the Molí de la Corriu. Here we will leave the car

With two cars:

The return car leaving Sant Llorenç de Morunys on the LV-4241 towards Berga, at km. 39.5 we take the road that goes to the left to La Corriu and Valls, we will go up along the river until a very characteristic sharp left curve where we park.

With the access car we return to the LV-4241 towards Berga until we find at the p.k. 42,6 on the left the indicator of Sisquer-Montcalb, which we will take. We will pass the hermitage of Sant Esteve de Sisquer and after almost 6 kilometers we will find a track on the left towards the Parera and the Molí de la Corriu. After a kilometer we have the parking of the Salt del Lanó and a kilometer later the one of Perera.

Approach: (machine translated)

With two cars we will go down the "riverbed" until we reach a lower track below the Perera, here soon begins the descent.

With one car, along the track that leaves from the Molí heading south up gently until it ends below the Perera, here we take the riverbed to start descending.

Tour: (machine translated)

Very entertaining, with the cave right in the middle of the descent, where you can enjoy its formations.

Return: (machine translated)



When we reach the river we go uphill a few meters to cross it and go up to the track on the other side. If we have a return car we will take the track to the left, downstream to the road. If we have only one car we will go to the right, upstream to go up to the Molí.
