Starting point in Telde

We take the GC131 towards Lomo Magullo and the "Baco Los Cernícalos" valley. Once in Lomo Magullo, we cross the village and turn right at the end of the village onto the GC132 towards Los Arenales and Baco Los Cernícalos. After 2 kilometers we reach the rest area at the exit of the valley, where we park the vehicle for the return trip. With the access vehicle, we return to Lomo Magullo to continue south on the GC131 and turn onto the GC130 towards La Breña. We pass La Breña and at km 16.5 we come across a very tight left-hand bend (a hairpin bend) and a path on the right-hand side that is closed to vehicles (there is parking in front of the fence).

Follow the path

After 800 m we turn right and after just under one and a half kilometers the canyon is directly to our right; we leave the path and walk into the river bed.
