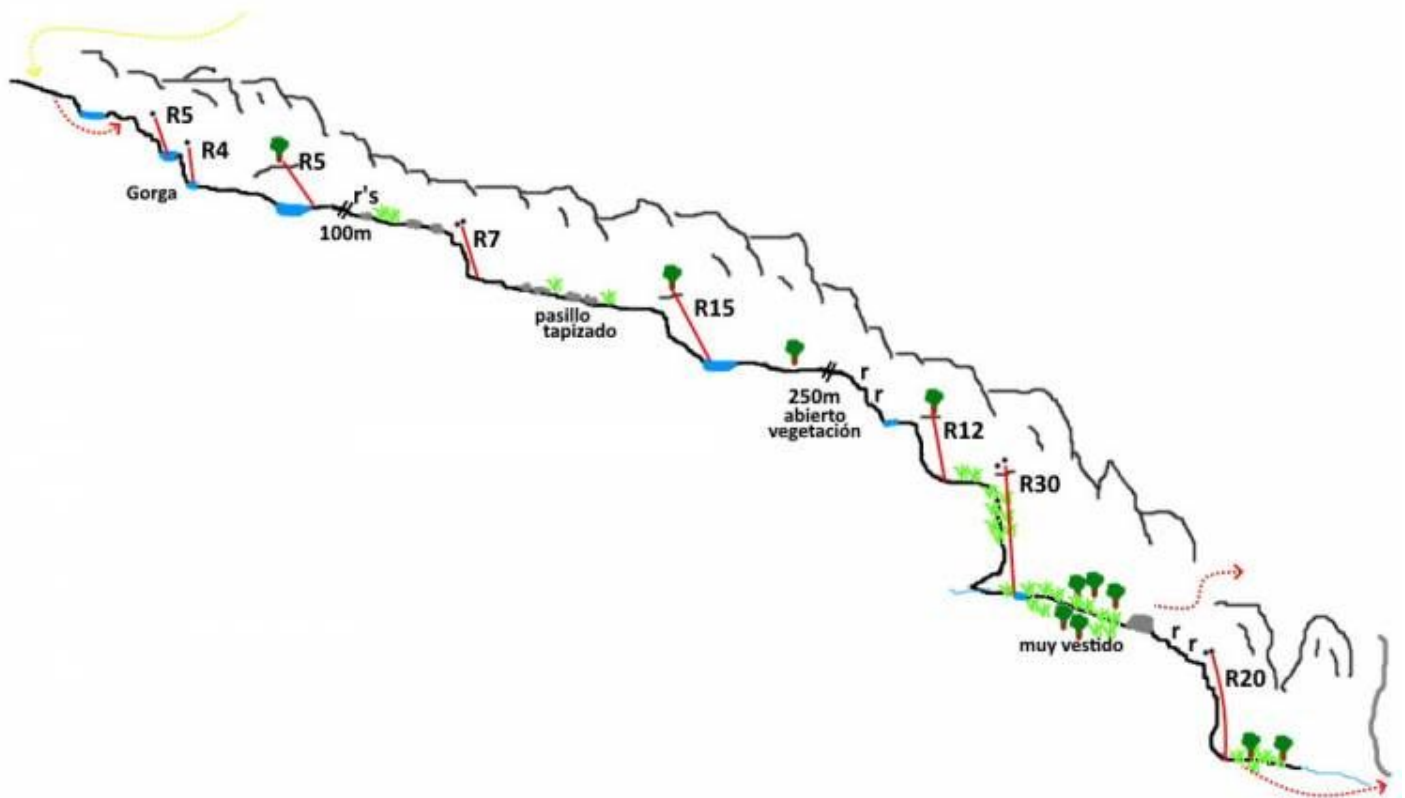

Very dressed, excessively for many people, for its lack of flow, it has an interesting first part, a middle section without any interest and the end with the biggest verticals, although also very dressed. Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Pamplona on NA-700 towards Lizarra/Estella Just in the p.k. 29 we have the detour to the right to the NA-7020 to Vidaurre. In 4 kms we will arrive at Guembe, along the San Antonio street there is a track that goes north, we will get into it and park about 2kms away, next to the second fence, where the two races meet. With the access car if we have it we will continue along the road to Munárriz, at the back of the village there is a track to the W-SW that in about 1km arrives at a small fork to the left, park here.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access to the Burón and Euntzelaia bcos. If we have an access car, the approach is simple, we must follow this track/path almost lost until the head of the Burón. If we only have a car, from the parking lot of Guembe we will follow the track to the north, like the access of Euntzelaia, until about 100m before the track disappears, here we will go to the left to look for a meadow hidden behind a line of vegetation, from here we will follow some milestones that lead us to the north, we will have to cross a wire fence and overcome the hill between thick vegetation, to approach by the orographic left to the ravine and go up it by a not very intuitive path.		
Tour: (machine translated) A very interesting first part, with a lot of atmosphere, a small gorge and a gallery that will end too soon to give way to an open intermediate zone, with too much vegetation to approach the final verticals, also very dressed.		
Return: (machine translated) We will go out to the right along a small path and further on we will cross the stream to go to the access road.
