Summary: (machine translated) Also known as Barranco de Salt, generally dry except after rains, it has only one rappel so it can be a good option to start. To combine with Buscarrons.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Access to Bot We will have to be located between Bot and Prat del Comte. Access to Bot By the N430 near Gandesa and we will turn off to Bot by the TV3531. By the C12 if we go from Tortosa detour to Prat del Comte. By the road that joins both towns, the TV3301, two kilometers after leaving Bot we cross the Canaletes river and we will have a track on the right, we get in here and park at the confluence of Bco Serbis and Trullet the car of return. If we have two cars we will continue along the road until pk 5. On the left we have a place to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Accesses to the Serbis and Buscarrons bcos. With a car we will go up the road up to pk 5, it does not reach 3kms. From this point we get into the tributary, we will be able to avoid the slopes to go to the Bco Serbis at the height of the upwelling.		
Tour: (machine translated) Excavated areas, some narrow/dark not too big, kettles... if we take it with water, it has its own charm.		
Return: (machine translated) We will follow the riverbed to the exit
