Access to Vega de Pas area

We must arrive to Vega de Pas. From the N623 in Entrambasmestas we will take the CA263.

Ajam, Ajam Sup, Peñallana, Hormaza, Interminable, Yera and Yera 2 ravines.

Arriving at Vega de Pas we turn right to Puerto de Estacas de Trueba on the CA631. We will pass Yera and at km 13 a very sharp left turn, here comes a track to the cabins of Hormaza, we park the access car.

The return car will have been left at the north entrance of the tunnel "La Engaña" which we reach by turning off at km 5 on the road down to the old railroad station and continuing along the track.

By the track that goes to the cabins of the Hormaza. Where the track ends we have the basin of our ravine, we must go down the rope a few meters and then if we go to the riverbed and enter about 1050m high.

We can continue along the Ajan Superior to the bridge, to take the track of the old railroad.

Or cross to take a path that goes along the orographic left of the Ajan ravine that finally connects with the track.
