<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) The middle part of the canyon starts with a 53 meter rappel. At the beginning, the canyon is not without charm, with a quick succession of rappels, but then a 30-minute walk to the Halden Bridge, followed by another 1-hour walk, interrupted by a few less rappels and a short, attractive narrow passage. At the end, the route becomes even narrower and more attractive.

<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From the highway Bregenz - Feldkirch on the exit "Klaus" (next exit after "Götzis"), then right (!) to the traffic circle, here 90 degrees to the left and in southern direction parallel to the highway about 1 km. Here follow the signpost to Dafins on the left. Pass under the freeway, after about 2.5 km cross the federal road 190 and continue in an easterly direction through the village area between Röthis and Sulz. At the exit the road crosses the Frödisch brook. Park the first vehicle here. With the second vehicle up to Dafins and through the village. Before the next leftward haipin bend (bus stop) turn right and follow the road for a few hundred meters until you reach a sharp right bend (Holzstoß / Grünzeug 2022) Park the car here.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the leftward haipin bend (with bus stop), take the forest road that goes uphill in a southerly direction, passing a fallow deer enclosure (2009) with a house on the right and reaching the small tarred road. Continue on it until you reach the houses at its exit. From there a few meters further downhill in a southerly direction (fountain), take the right path at the fork and follow it downhill to the footbridge over the stream.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Entry with c53, then short rappel and downclimb in relatively narrow canyon, but then tiring rattling in the stony streambed. Next entry possibility at the bridge (from Dafins). Still walking (in total about 1.5 hrs), a rewarding interlude. Finally access for the lower part, which is then interesting again.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) You can get off at the footbridge to the right up to Dafins, where the access to the middle section takes place (655 m a.s.l.). It is possible to continue along the middle part and then follow the lower part. After this, at the road bridge, go up to the right and left to the lower vehicle.
