When we arrive at the abandoned power station we can exit to the left towards the power station where we park. On the right along the agricultural trails next to the San Paio river to the chapel.

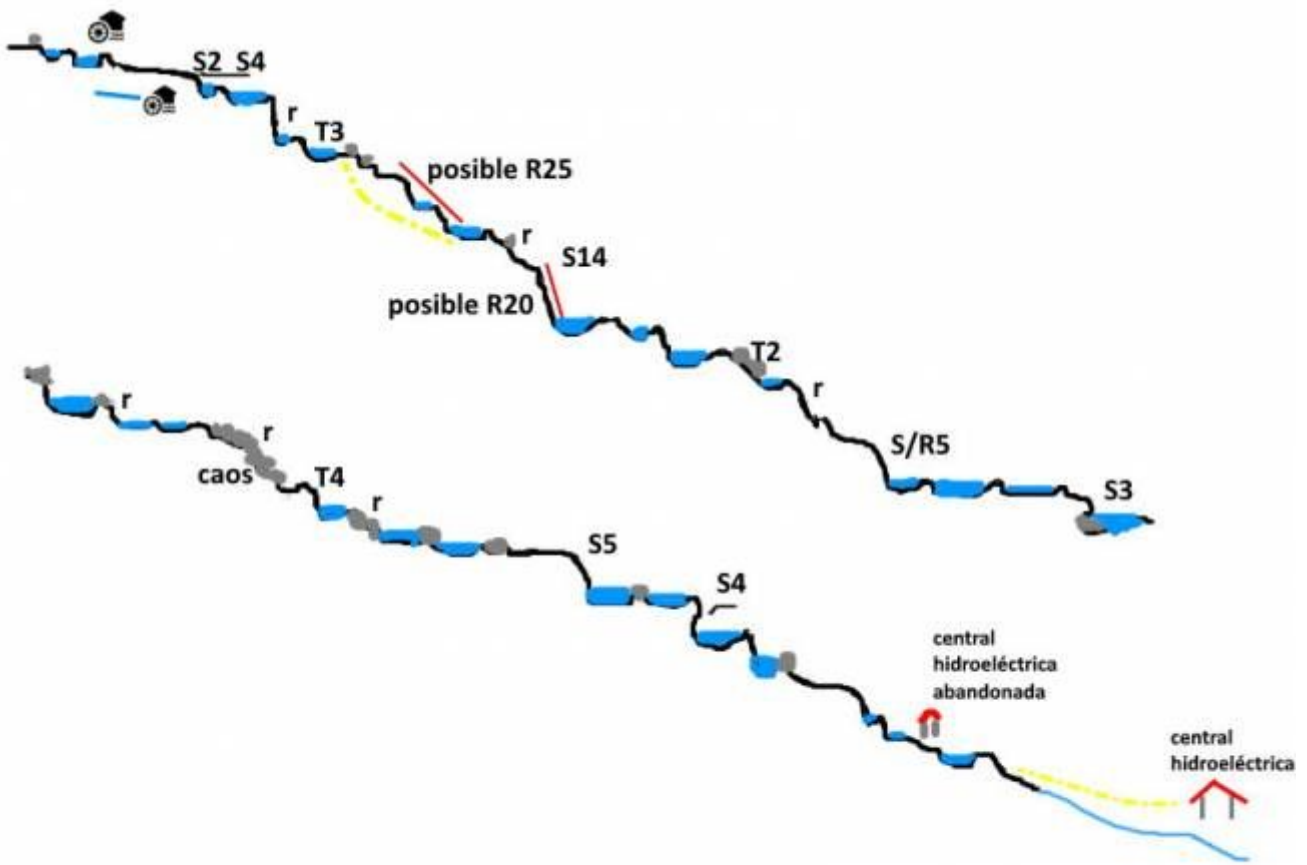
