<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Medium-high rappels, a few small jumps and super beautiful geography.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Important (no alternative route before the lower part of the large waterfall).		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Locarno drive first towards the Maggia valley --> follow the road to the village of Bignasco --> there follow the signs to Brontallo. Drive past the exit to Brontallo for approx. 900m. A hiking trail crosses the road here. We park the car here.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the car, follow the path downhill to the bridge over the Maggia. Cross the Maggia and keep right on the opposite side (path from the stream). At the next junction, keep left again towards the stream. Cross the stream and you will soon come to a path where you keep to the right and head towards the village of "Pianello". In the village, keep right towards the stream and cross into the valley slightly downhill until you reach the streambed.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Short canyon with medium rappels, not too technical a few small jumps. Very nice geography.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) A little way down the Maggia BEFORE the bridge on the opposite bank, take a small path to the bridge. Then turn right to the car.
