Summary: (machine translated)

The Candís river canyon is in the municipality of O Barco de Valdeorras (in the province of Ourense).

It is of intermediate level, spectacular for its crystal clear waters, emerald green color, rappels, small slides and jumps to incredible pools.

The most surprising thing about this canyon is that we start walking on a bed of slate and as we go deeper into the ravine the water flows under our feet.

It is a ravine that will surprise you with its beauty and crystal clear waters.

All this makes this ravine a small water park in the middle of this wonderful mountain range.

You will discover its natural beauty during the descent, walking along the river, overcoming obstacles and sliding down the rapids between natural slides.

Water ravine, boxed and in slate, if we find it with the right flow is a real water park to enjoy, as it is one of the best in the area. Caution if in the initial part we see that the stream has a lot of flow because later it will be strong. Very frequented ravine, for the companies of the zone. Very well equipped.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From the town of O Barco de Valdeorras (Ourense) we take the N536 road towards Ponferrada.

Just in the pk 43 we arrive to Candís, to some industrial warehouses where we can park the car of return or if we only have a car.

With the access car we continue straight on for 800m until the detour to the right to Doniz. We will go until we see a dump on our right and a place to park, a little further on there is a track on the left where we could park on the side. Another option is to continue to the bridge (about 100m ahead).

Approach: (machine translated)

Red: approach

Light blue: bco sport part

Green: return

Dark blue: return with 2 cars / blueberry tree

With only one car we will have to go up the road, we can take a shortcut just after leaving the industrial buildings by a track on the right. From there we will go to the area of the dump or the bridge.

Once we are in the Parking 1, there we will change to do the activity. We will make the approach to the ravine. We will get in, by a path that goes to the right of the road. With fairly high grass, we will go down, we will see a ruin on the right hand side. At the end of the road, there will be a path on the right. We will have to go over it until we reach the river.

From the area of the dump leaves a path that takes us down to the stream and after passing some honeycombs we go to the right and to the riverbed.

From the bridge it is immediate but we will have to walk through an uninteresting area until the first difficulty.

Sports canyon, medium technical. Very frequented by many companies in the area or surroundings especially in the summer season.

It is an adventure park: with slides, high jumps and rappels.

It is a ravine, which usually carries a lot of water, as it is tucked in a valley of mountains, with enough height, including Peña Trevinca 2127m (O teito de Galiza).must be very careful in times of thaw, even if we are in full spring, as this 2024, comes quite loaded. The ideal height is 50cm of height in the middle parts of the mountain.
