<b>Gear:</b> Ropes: 2x30m		
<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) varied - jumps, slides, rappel, climbing through tree stumps. Partly it looks wilder than it is. Pools often only very shallow!		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Rocky catchment area, unpleasant during thunderstorms.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Directly to the Haldensee. Choose the parking lot for Tauscher's Alm or Naturcamping at Haldensee as your destination.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot, cross the bridge and then follow the path to the right. You can check the water level at the slide brake or shortly afterwards at the small bridge. Then continue uphill along the steep hiking trail on the orographic right-hand side, then on the forest road until it crosses the Strindenbach stream at a bridge.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The first third up to the A27 is relatively open with small slides or possible jumps into rather shallow! pools. The canyon then becomes more incised and after the 27m rappel still offers very nice steps with mostly shallow pools. In places, however, there are large blockages that need to be watched out for. If the water level is high, diverters for rope traverses can be used at critical points to avoid the water. The anchors here are drilled quite high and may be more difficult to reach from below.  At the exit, the stream surprises again with a somewhat narrower gulch that offers some nice slides.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the brick slide brake (last rappel directly on the concrete on the left), continue a few meters further until you can easily exit to the right onto the access path at a water extraction point on the left bank.		
<b>Coordinates:</b> Canyon Start <a href="#">47.4800 10.5595</a> Canyon End <a href="#">47.4893 10.5643</a> Parking Entry and Exit <a href="#">47.4897 10.5666</a>

Anchorage and ropes are all in good condition. Today there was a little more water than "normal", but it still went very well. The pools were all covered in gravel (mostly only knee-deep), no jumps possible. Slides were no problem everywhere. Towards the exit there were a lot of branches in the stream, which also had to be bypassed in a more complicated way. Two anchors were in an awkward position, no idea how you would normally get there
