Getting to Yeste

At the exit of Yeste we take the detour to the left to the A63 to La Graya. We will pass it and continue to Marchana. When we arrive here we continue straight on towards Casas de Enmedio, before arriving (about 800m from the detour) we can park, and we will see the great vertical on our left.

With the access car, if we have it we return to the crossroads and follow the road, we pass the viewpoint and 2kms later a track comes out on the right to a ruined farmhouse. We park the access car here.

Approach: (machine translated)

With the access car we will go along the track (GR) leaving the strut to our left for a kilometer until a path that goes off to our left (west) and goes to the riverbed and the walls. We will only have to go down to the riverbed. With a car we will have to return by the road until almost the crossing, there leaves a path to our right that ascends towards the walls, zigzagging, with great views, we will surpass the wall and we will stay at the foot of the strut, just in the same track that from the car. We will take the path that goes to our right towards the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first section of short rappels to approach the big vertical. It is broken into 30+70 with an access handrail. Caution with the friction.

In the middle of winter, ice sheets can form, endangering the anchors and access.

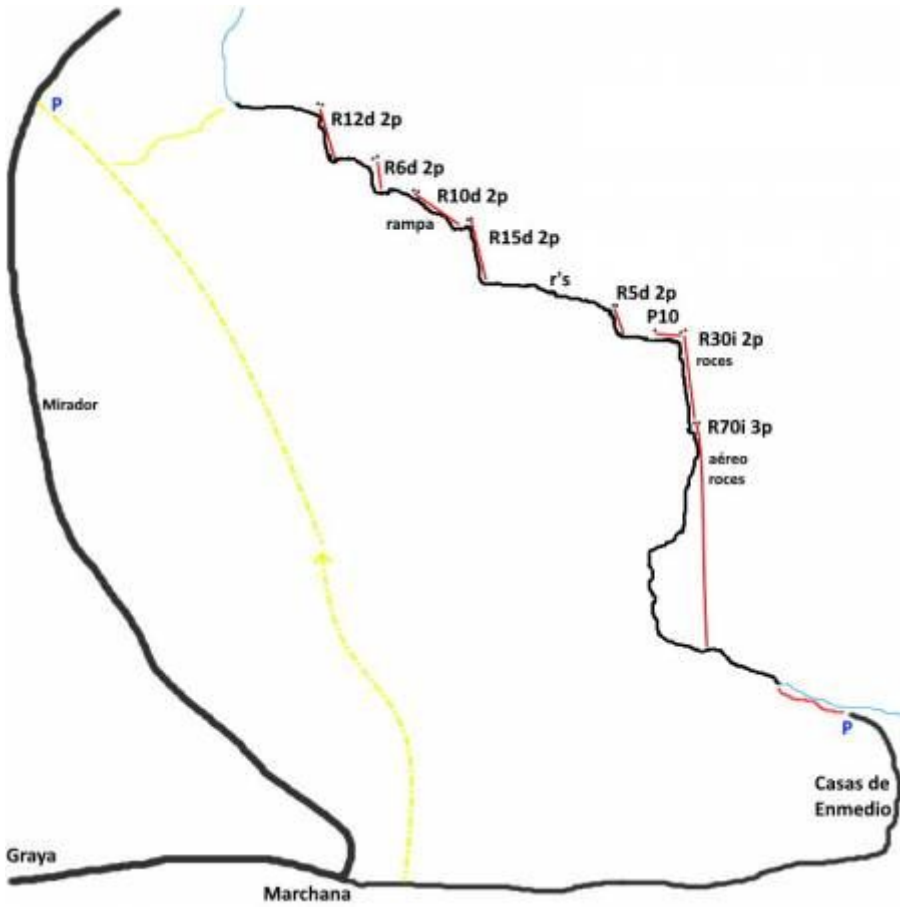
When we reach the bottom, we will continue to the right to reach the road where we will park.
