Summary: (machine translated)

At low water level probably rather simple canyon with only short abseil steps and many shallow beautifully washed out cols. Towards the exit of the canyon, however, is a siphon that can not be overcome with the current belay, therefore ATTENTION! Be sure to take material for belaying, we had too little material to lock over it. At the exit of the canyon is again a surprisingly aquatic, narrow place with several deep scours where even a jump of about 4m is possible.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Leave the A9 at Ried im Traunkreis and drive via Pettenbach, Scharnstein, Grünau into the Almtal valley. At Habernau (Gasthof Jagersimmerl) turn off in the direction of Ödseen, Almtalerhaus. After approx. 2.5km, park at a fork in the road, shortly (approx. 200m) before the bridge over the Stranegg.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow this forest road for approx. 1.3 km or 100 m until it forms a steep bend to the right. Here is the first possible entry. We followed the stream for about 500m and then climbed in, there are also a few small rappelling points. According to the map, there could be some more rewarding places above.

Tour: (machine translated)

The siphon towards the exit of the canyon was not entered by us because we did not know how deep it is, we got out of the canyon (which is absolutely not recommended) and then back in.

Return: (machine translated)

Cross the Straneggbach and back on the road to the car.
