Summary: (machine translated)

Dry canyon, parallel to Agustí, very well equipped and that can be combined with this on the same day or with the Patacons ferrata. Attention, unless the descent has been cleaned, it had a lot of vegetation. Caution with the exit of the rappels.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We must be located in Vilaplana, for it by the C14, exit La Selva, we will continue on the TP7013 to Vilaplana. By the T11 to the south of Reus, at the junction with the N420 we turn to the T704 to Vilaplana. Once there we will take the T704 towards Prades, halfway up, at pk 15.5 we will see an esplanade on the right that is the parking of the via ferrata.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access Morenet and Agustí

By the via ferrata of Patacons to the top or when you reach the Font de Roure turn right along the GR until almost the road and here to the left to join the exit path of the ferrata.

From above heading west towards Cal Morenet we will reach a fork just before the Cal, on the left the Morenet ravine there is a milestone that marks it for us. We will follow the milestones until the first cliff.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first cut with 3 rappels to descend to the Camí dels Cingles (return or escape), we will continue straight ahead to reach the second split vertical. Once past the vertical, after another couple of rappels we will find the Agustí on the right, we will do another rappel and reach the bottom.

Return: (machine translated)

We will cross a path that we will take to the right to go up the Barranc de les Tosques. From here we will go along the Camí dels Cingles with its yellow-blue markings. We will cross the Agustí and Morenet rivers, we will pass under the ferrata and we will arrive at the road.
