Leave the A 12 (Genoa - La Spezia) at Sestri Levante and take the SP 523. After Casarza Ligure, turn left uphill to Bargone. You can park your car on the left in the parking lot in front of the factory if you drive straight ahead for another 100 m on the SP 523.

At the top of Bargone, follow the road from the central parking lot in the direction of Bocco. After approx. 300 m - before the road branches off - a somewhat hidden dirt track on the right leads down to the stream. There is space for the 2nd car. You can also camp (wild) here (2001).

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Directly from the upper parking lot below the bridge.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The wooded canyon is relatively open and has some more attractive narrow sections. Sometimes there is garbage. The water looks clean. At the exit of the first narrow section is a nice 6 m slide; some jumps fail because the underwater is not deep enough. The belays are usually on steel cables attached to trees (sometimes hanging from above!).

**Return:** (machine translated)

As soon as you reach the two water drainage pipes, leave the streambed at the first opportunity and follow a path on the left bank. This leads to an old dam. Follow the drainage channel that begins here, go through a first tunnel in the channel and bypass two more. At the exit of the canal (approx. 50 m above the streambed), a path leads down to factory buildings, which you bypass on the left on a road. On the righthand side you come to the parking lot with the car parked below.
