From Reutte on the 198 up the Lech valley to Stanzach. 500 m after the center of Stanzach turn right, cross the Lech and drive 2.4 km to Vorderhornbach. There we take the Hornbacher Landstraße L264 and drive to Hinterhornbach, cross the hamlet and continue in the valley until we reach the no driving sign. Here we park our car in a suitable place.

Approach: (machine translated)

Now on foot - better still for the time being with a suitable bicycle - first on the orographic. left side of the Hornbaches brook upstream in the direction of Petersbergalpe. After about 600 m we cross to the southern side of the stream. Here further upstream we come after additional well 2 km to a bridge over the Hornbach and again well 500 m further to the so-called Drähhütten. A few hundred meters further we cross again to the southern bank of the Hornbach and reach 2.3 km after the Drähhütten the Petersbergalpe (1280m above sea level). Up to here we are on foot from the car 1 hour and 15 minutes. Once again we continue for about 1.5 km, then we come to the place where "our" brook splashes down from the right.\n\nNow the actual access begins, which is by no means easy to find. We look for tracks that lead up through the forest on the orographic right side of the stream: Out of the forest, we continue upward across meadows.\nSomewhat below the high waterfall, which is filled with avalanche debris into the fall, we traverse to the lower entry into the stream (at about 1550 m a.s.l.).\n\nIf we also want to walk the upper part, which is dangerous especially in the approach, we continue until we can traverse across steep flanks into the large basin. At the foot of a high waterfall, the descent in the upper part begins here at about 1660m above sea level.
