Summary: (machine translated) Low water rappel canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Zurich on the A 1 in the direction of Bern. 70 km after the "Würrenlos" rest stop (on the western outskirts of Zurich), change from the A 1 to the A 5. Passing Solothurn and the northern end of Lake Biel near Bienne, we enter the Swiss Jura. 45.5 km after leaving the A 1 onto the A 5, we turn off the A 5 onto the "Route de Bienne" (No. 30) and drive via Sombeval and Corgemont to Cortebert (7.8 km from leaving the A 5). In the center of the town, we take "Les Cheseaux" south and cross the Suze River and the railroad. Take the second road to the left after the railroad crossing and then immediately to the right and we head for the slopes of the "Foret de l'Envers". 850 m after turning "Les Cheseaux" we turn right on the road that leads southwest to a stone bridge over the Chenau de l'Envers (550 m from the last turnoff) Here we park the lower car. \nWith the second one we go back to the junction and then uphill in the "Foret de l'Envers". From the junction we go uphill for 4.1 km, then we turn right at a sharp angle. Shortly through the forest we come to a large meadow area, pass the first homestead and park our upper car at the next homestead (1 km from the last junction - 1120 m above sea level).		
Approach: (machine translated) From this farmstead in a westerly direction to the canyon rim and then on a path on the slope in a southerly direction down to the stream. Entry at the bridge. In their book, Brunner/Betrissey come to the same access point from the other side of the stream (see there). If the western parking lot is chosen, follow the branching forest path uphill until you leave it at a bend to cross the edge of the forest towards the canyon at almost the same height. When the forest bends, descend to the canyon on a narrow and somewhat exposed path.		
Tour: (machine translated) Pure rappel canyon with 15 rappels, no emergency exit. The first part is an alternation of running routes and rappels. The middle section is the deepest and most attractive part of the canyon. The end is formed by a few open rappels and running routes.

Before the stone bridge turn right out to the car.
